

# POTTY TRAINING

FOR DOGS AND PUPPIES ALIKE



- The only time un-potty trained pups should get free reign of the house is after they have emptied their bladder/colon and when they are being supervised
- It is up to the humans of the house to ensure their pup is in the right place at the right time when the urge comes along!
- Scolding pups for going potty in areas deemed "inappropriate" will only confuse the pup and teach them they are better off finding a secret place to potty when the humans aren't looking
- The use of a crate or a confined area is the key to success-- if given too much space all at once, an accident is bound to happen
- After the pup has finished going potty, it is essential to reward them heavily. Five treats in a row and happy tones is a treat party!
- Setting timers will help to ensure the pup is taken outside before it is too late, this is a key component for success
